

Two distinct buildings are connected through a long white concrete veil. The coherence and balance of the whole is maintained by the homogenous treatment of the façades. The different shapes and similar materials make fraternal twins out of these two buildings, which works to maintain options for future users of the space. The differences between the buildings would allow multiple tenants to maintain an air of individuality while at the same time the continuous architectural themes provide an appropriate environment for a single occupant. The sunshade, a major element of the façade, brings the bright comfort crucial to the offices and open spaces of the building.




